1. Complete and Organized Health Records

A well-bred doodle comes with **full health documentation**, including:

- Vaccines (dates and product names)
- Deworming schedule and medications
- Parent health testing/screening info
- Microchip details if applicable

Tip: Delayed or vague paperwork may indicate skipped care.

2. Verified Veterinary Care

Ethical breeders involve a licensed veterinarian before pickup:

- Full physical exam
- Heart, joints, eyes, and bite check
- Weight and overall condition notes

Red flag: Skipping vet visits or treating them as optional.

3. Intentional Doodle Puppy Socialization

Socialization begins **long before training**:

- Daily human interaction from multiple people
- Exposure to normal household noise
- Handling of paws, ears, and mouth
- Short separations to build confidence

Note: Lack of early socialization can lead to anxiety, not bad behavior.

4. Clear, Written Contract

Contracts ensure long-term accountability:

- Health guarantees
- Spay/neuter expectations
- Return or rehoming policies
- Breeder responsibilities post-placement

Tip: No contract = little accountability after pickup.

5. Transition Guidance for Real Life

Ethical breeders provide practical guidance:

- Current diet and feeding schedule
- Sleep and crate routines
- Early training expectations
- Recognizing adjustment stress

Result: Reduces panic and prevents early mistakes.

6. Ongoing Breeder Access

Breeder support doesn't end at pickup:

- Answer behavior or training questions
- Address health changes
- Stay available for guidance

Red flag: Breeders who disappear after sale.

7. Why This Matters

Breed names are secondary. **What counts is preparation, transparency, and accountability.**

At Hidden Road Doodles:

- Puppies go home with documentation, structure, and continued support
 - Families feel confident and supported from day one
 - Ethical breeding creates calm, happy, well-adjusted puppies
